BYLC distributes winter clothes

The first leadership programme graduates of Bangladesh Youth Leadership Centre (BYLC) in Chittagong launched a winter clothes distribution campaign at Kushumbagh on Friday.

The students distributed sweaters among the poor men and women in the local slum, says a press release.

President of BYLC Changemaker Forum Minhaz Morshed said, "Leadership is about serving others and we organised this campaign to help the underprivileged sections of our community who have been suffering a lot in the cold winter."

"Our hope is to continue such initiatives in future and also to encourage other young people in the port city to take such voluntary community-based initiatives," he added.

Originally developed at Harvard Kennedy School, BYLC is now being established as a premier youth leadership centre in Bangladesh.

BYLC works to bridge gaps in the society by uniting youth from diverse backgrounds, equipping them with leadership, problem solving and teamwork skills as well as engaging them in community service and active citizenship.
